With your generous support, Downtown Oklahoma City Partnership activated the downtown area during the 21st season of Downtown in December and promoted over 30 events and attractions from November 2022 to January 2023.

Downtown in December presented by Devon provided a central location for residents and visitors to experience the holiday season the downtown way. The series highlighted numerous free or low-cost community events produced not only by our organization and its districts, but by local nonprofits and businesses throughout downtown. It listed opportunities to visit and take photos with Santa through Downtown OKC's Santa Tracker and added ways to engage online with a new video series.

## **Oklahoma City Tree Lighting Festival**

The Oklahoma City Tree Lighting Festival serves as the annual kickoff to the holiday season and Downtown in December. Each year, this long-standing community tradition features free family-friendly activities, a showcase of diverse live performances celebrating the season, and the countdown to the lighting of the Bricktown Christmas tree by the Mayor and Santa Claus.

The 21st festival took place on Thursday, November 17th, returning in person to Bricktown for the first time since 2019. Over 1,000 attendees enjoyed 10 performances representing the many cultures and traditions we have in Oklahoma City before and after the tree was lit. Pop-up booths, food trucks, photos with Santa, and the Letters to Santa station added to the festive atmosphere.





The annual Lights On Broadway event and attraction returned for its 7th year this season with over 630,000 LED lights and plenty of winter-themed activities and business promotions throughout the district.






## **OUR REACH**
